Year 1 National Curriculum Objectives for Art: Children will be taught to:
Artists/sculptures studied: Paul Klee, Andy Goldsworthy

Year 1 Artists and their Work • Explore the work of the artists/sculptures listed above • Evaluate the work of the listed artists using the language of art e.g. colour • Describe what they see and say whether they like the work

<u>Drawing</u>

- Experiment with and control marks made with different media e.g. pencils, crayons, felt tips, chalk
- Experiment making different lines with different media e.g. thick, thin, wavy, straight, zig zag
- Accurately draw people's faces
- Draw a self-portrait, using pencil, with features in the correct place

Use of IT/Digital Media

- Use 2Paint to create simple paintings
- Use the internet to find out about their focus artists and to explore their work

<u>Printing</u>

- Print with a variety of hard and soft materials e.g. potatoes, sponge, cork, fruit and vegetables
- Create a repeating pattern using patterns in the environment as inspiration

Exploring and Evaluating Ideas

- Record and explore ideas from first hand observations
- Develop ideas, try things out and make changes
- Make links between their work and the work of artists

Painting

- Choose appropriate tools to paint with e.g. thick brushes to paint larger areas and smaller, fine brushes for more detailed work
- Know that red, blue and yellow are primary colours
- Add white and black to the primary colours to create different shades and tones
- Add texture to paint through the use of sand

3D Design

- Use a variety of materials, both natural and man-made to create different shapes and sculptures using the work of Andy Goldsworthy as a starting point
- Work safely with a variety of materials and tools e.g. scissors, wire, playdough
- Experiment with joining and building using recycled, natural and man-made materials

Textiles/Collage

- Create images from a variety of media e.g. photographs, pictures, words, fabric, thread
- Fold, crumple, tear and overlap paper
- Sort/choose materials according to their texture
- Use paper to weave
- Weave using natural material e.g. grass through sticks
- Use scissors and glue safely and with increasing accuracy
