


Science- Living Things and their Habitats

Numeracy

Place Value

- Count in multiples of 5, 7, 9, 25 and 100
- Find 1000 more or less than a given number
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 4 digit number (thousands, hundreds, tens, ones)
- Order and compare numbers beyond 1000
- Round any number to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
- Solve number and practical problems that involve the above and with increasingly large positive numbers

Addition and Subtraction

- Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using the formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction where appropriate
- Solve addition and subtraction two step problems in contexts deciding which operations to use and why

Multiplication and Division

- Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12
- Multiplying by 0 and 1
- Dividing by 1
