

Numeracy-

Multiplication and Division

- Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12
- Recognise and use factor pairs and commutativity in mental calculations
- Multiply 2 digit and 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit number using a formal written layout
- Solve problems involving multiplying and adding, including using the distributive law to multiply 2 digit numbers by 1 digit

Fractions and Decimals

- Recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions
- Add and subtract fraction with the same denominator
- Find the effect of multiplying or dividing a 1 or 2 digit number by 10 and 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones, tenths and hundredths
- Solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities and fractions to divide quantities including non-unit fractions where the answer is a whole number

Measurement

- Convert between different units of measure (for example km to m and hr to min)
- Measure and calculate the perimeter of a rectilinear figure (including squares) in cm and m

Geography-

- Use the 8 points of a compass
- Use 4-figure grid references
