I have been finding out about my great great grandparents from my nana (Pat Crosby).

My great great grandparents were John Littler and Emily Gee. They both went to St Mary's Birchley school starting about 1894/95.

Before they married they lived next door to each other at 204 and 202 Main Street Billinge, which is were Willowbrook Hospice shop is now. They left school age 13. My great grandad John known as Jack became a Coal Miner and my great grandma was a maid at the Masons Arms in Carr Mill Road Billinge.

They were married at St Mary's Church on the 7th of November 1914. They had three children one of them being my great grandad Austin Littler (my Nana's dad) My great grandad Austin and his two sisters (Veronica and Mildred) also went to St Mary's School.

Veronica Littler my great grandads oldest sister was the first girl to pass the scholarship to a grammar school from Birchley and my great grandad was the first boy to pass.

Sadly, my great great grandma Emily died when she was 31. At that time there was an orphanage in Billinge run by nuns called "Greenfield". The nuns took a great interest in Vera and Austin and helped them educationally and were very kind to them.

My great great grandad John Littler retired when he was 65 after working all his life "down the pit".

In 1968 the row of cottages where he lived were demolished to make way for the row of shops that are there now. He died in 1972 aged 81.
