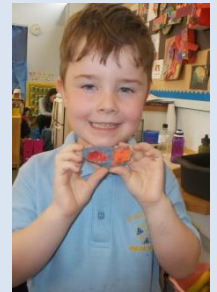
We celebrated Emily's amazing cave painting. She is proving to be quite the artist. Well done 😊

Library

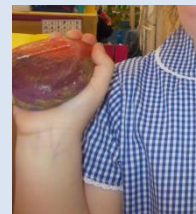
Since September we have had lots of library books go missing. So we have decided to review our library system to ensure it works for us all – we will be visiting the library again in the next few weeks.
