

Adding Vowel Suffixes to Spell Longer Words

Instructions

1. Pick a card
2. Read the root word and the suffix on the front of the card.
3. Use the checklist to work out how to spell the new word that will be made.
4. Turn the card around to see if you were right.

Checklist

Double the final consonant of the root word if:

- ✓ The word ends with one vowel and a consonant (e.g. -at, -en)
- ✓ The word has more than one syllable (e.g. hello)
- ✓ The last syllable of the word is stressed (e.g. forgot or channel)
